ORDINANCE 2019-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BAY HEAD, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BAY HEAD, SO AS TO AMEND CHAPTER 222, ENTITLED, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" TO MODIFY THE ALLOWABLE TRUCK OR MOTOR VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMIT FOR PARKING ON ROADWAYS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF BAY HEAD

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Bay Head, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Municipal Code of the Borough of Bay Head is hereby amended and supplemented so as to amend §222-17, entitled "Parking of vehicles in excess of four tons restricted", so as to increase the gross weight limit to six tons. Section §222-20is hereby amended to read in entirety as following:

§ 222-17Parking of vehicles in excess of six tons restricted.

There shall be no parking, at any time, of any truck or motor vehicle in excess of six tons' gross weight on any municipal, state or county roadway, except for the pickup and delivery of goods, merchandise or materials or to provide services, within the Borough of Bay Head.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
