



Introducing the Ocean County Special Needs Registry

The **Ocean County Special Needs Registry** is a **voluntary** service open to all citizens with special needs who reside attend school or are employed in Ocean County. The registry was created to help police officers and other emergency service personnel better assist residents with special needs in the event of an emergency providing those first responders with vital information regarding a registrant's special needs emergency contact information, physical description and current photograph of the registrant.

Information about an OCSNR registrant shall be kept strictly confidential.

All registrants will be issued window decals to be placed prominently on the front entrance of their residence as well as on their personal vehicle. The presence of the OCSNR decal should signify that someone in the residence/vehicle has some degree of special need and first responders should respond accordingly.

The Ocean County Special Needs Registry is a joint collaboration between the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office, the Ocean County Sheriff's Office and the Ocean County Chiefs of Police Association.
