

ORDINANCE 2020-17

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BAY HEAD,
COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE MUNICIPAL
CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BAY HEAD, SO AS TO
AMEND CHAPTER 157, ENTITLED "MOBILE HOMES
AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES"**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Bay Head, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Municipal Code of the Borough of Bay Head is hereby amended and supplemented so as to amend Chapter 157, entitled "Mobile Homes and Recreational Vehicles" so as to amend §157-2(H) in its entirety, so that it shall read as follows:

H. Commercial and contractors' trailers, equipment, and vehicles may be parked on Borough streets on the same block as the property having work performed from 8 a.m. through 6 p.m. Monday through Friday only. Contractors' equipment of any kind, including, but not limited to, bulldozers, trailers, front-end loaders, or backhoes may only be parked on private property overnight upon approval of the Code Enforcement Officer who shall determine whether there is sufficient space that the equipment can be located without encroaching on any applicable setback lines for the zoning district in which the property is located. Such approval shall be requested during the construction permit process.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
