

# SCHEDULE OF FEES and GUARANTEES/DEPOSITS

## ROAD OPENING/EXCAVATION

BAY HEAD, NJ

### APPLICATION FEES

Up to 50 square feet (sf):	\$100.00
Over 50 sf and up to 100 sf:	\$150.00
Over 100 sf and up to 200 sf:	\$200.00
Over 200 sf and up to 400 sf:	\$400.00
Greater than 400 sf:	\$400.00 + \$0.50 for each sf over 400 sf

### PERFORMANCE GUARANTEES and DEPOSITS

- A. Each applicant for a permit shall post a performance guarantee with the Borough Clerk. The value of the guarantee shall be determined using current regional public sector unit prices for all items which shall include but not be limited to excavation; pipe bedding; backfilling and compaction; temporary and permanent pavement restoration; curb, sidewalk and driveway apron restoration; lawn restoration; soil erosion and sediment control; dewatering; off-site disposal of excavated material; traffic control including police services; and all other labor, equipment and materials necessary to complete the opening. Costs of engineering related to permit reviews, inspections and testing shall also be included.
- B. Not less than twenty (20%) percent of the performance guarantee amount shall be by cash or certified check paid to the Borough as a deposit. This deposit shall be required in addition to the permit application fee and shall be retained through the maintenance period by the Borough and until the Public Works Supervisor has issued his final approval indicating that the opening complied with permit requirements and that final restoration has been completed to his satisfaction.
- C. The remaining 80% of the performance guarantee amount shall be cash, letter of credit or approved bond with a company licensed to do business in New Jersey.
- D. When, in the opinion of the Public Works Supervisor review and continuous inspection by the Borough Engineer during working hours of the work of the Permittee is necessary, such services shall be a condition of the Permit. All services provided by the Borough Engineer shall be at the expense of the Permittee. The Borough Engineer shall estimate the amount of the fees required for such services. Those fees shall be deposited with the Borough Clerk prior to the issuance of the permit.
